Contestants must be enrolled as an undergraduate student in an institution within the ASAS Midwestern Section or ADSA Midwest Branch which offers a baccalaureate degree in Agriculture at the time of abstract submission. Undergraduate students enrolled in institutions outside of the Midwest region or at institutions that do not offer degrees in Agriculture may also enter the competition as long as either the student or the advisor is a member of the ASAS Midwestern Section or the ADSA Midwest Branch.
