The goal of a good poster is to communicate quality research to the readers. Therefore, the criteria utilized to evaluate posters will be clarity, completeness, design, understanding of the topic, materials, methods and results. The poster should include a title, authors and their affiliation, hypothesis, abstract, objectives, materials and methods, results and conclusion. Innovative and high quality research will be valued. The organization of the poster to assist the reader will be evaluated.

Students must be enrolled as an undergraduate at an institution within the ASAS Midwestern Section or ADSA Midwest Branch which offers a baccalaureate degree in agriculture at the time of abstract submission. If their institution is located outside the Midwest Section or does not offer a degree in agriculture, the student or their advisor must be a member of the ASAS Midwestern Section or ADSA Midwest Branch.
