

The Tim S. Stahly Outstanding Swine Nutrition Midwest Graduate Student Award

1. Name of Award: The Tim S. Stahly Outstanding Swine Nutrition Midwest Graduate Student Award
2. Nature of Award: A one-time monetary award and a plaque. Amount of monetary award should be set by the evaluation committee yearly and should be based on sustainability of Tim Stahly Fund. The award should not exceed \$500.00.
3. Purpose: To recognize achievement of an outstanding swine nutrition graduate student. In particular, to recognize outstanding research, extension and teaching efforts of a Midwest graduate student in the area of swine nutrition.
4. Eligibility for Nomination: To be eligible the candidate must be a graduate student at or within six months of the time of the nomination for the award. The graduate student's fundamental research or extension program should be in swine nutrition. The award is open to both MS and PhD level students, although it is likely that students nearing the end of their programs will be more competitive than students at the beginning of their program. There are no restrictions on country of residence; however, candidates do need to be current members of ASAS and of the Midwestern Section of ASAS
5. Each nomination must contain the following by **October 29, 2008**:
 - a. A biography of the nominee not to exceed 2000 characters and spaces.
 - b. A summary of scholarly work noting the impact of the work on swine nutrition. This summary will not exceed 5,000 characters and spaces.
 - c. Letters of support from 3 members of ASAS. One of the letters must be from the individual's major professor.
 - d. A current résumé or curriculum vitae.
 - e. A citation for reading at the awards ceremony (not to exceed 750 characters and spaces).
